#### Tree and Bush Debris **ONLY**

**NO** stumps, roots, weeds, grass, lumber, trash, etc.

Maximum Length - 6 Feet Maximum Diameter - 8 Inches

NOTE: Do Not remove all your needles, they provide nutrients to the soil

Loads MUST be securely tied in transit.

Keep children and pets in vehicle.


