

MEDICATION DISPOSAL INFORMATION

What is allowed?

- Liquid medications (sealed in the original container)
- Medicated ointments and lotions
- Over-the-counter medicines
- Pet medications
- Prescription medications
- Prescription patches
- Vitamins

What is not allowed?

- Bloody or infectious waste
- Chemotherapy drugs
- Needles or sharps of any kind
- Personal care products
- Thermometers
- Schedule I controlled substances such as marijuana, heroin or LSD

Put all pills in one zip-top bag, seal it tightly and drop the bag into the collection receptacle. Trash or recycle the empty pill containers after you remove or scratch out personal information. If other packaging, such as cardboard boxes, can be easily removed, please dispose of it separately.
